Mr. Swentor is a veteran of the technology industry with over 25 years of experience, and increasing levels of responsibility ranging from front-line IT hardware and software sales, implementation and support, to IT and Sales Operations management experience.

Mr. Swentor joined NovaQuest in 2008 as its first Director of IT and Sales Operations. He was recruited by NovaQuest CEO, Joel Lemke, when NovaQuest was formed.

Prior to joining NovaQuest, Mr. Swentor's IT career began in 1984 at a national computer reseller/ implementer as a hardware and software salesman and network support engineer. In 1993 he worked for the office of the chairman of a large national bank as the IT support engineer responsible for the maintenance of the chairman's private network and all applications. In 1997 he joined IBM Global Services assisting departments who were migrating from the IBM network to become stand-alone products. In 1998, while on assignment to ENOVIA/Dassault Systèmes, he was asked to stay and be a part of their information technology team. In 2003, Mr. Swentor played a major role in the creation of the ENOVIA/Dassault Systèmes headquarters in Charlotte, NC. In 2005, Mr. Swentor was part of the global management team which was responsible for the world-wide implementation of the Dassault Systèmes IT collaboration and infrastructure process.
